Higher Education/Vocational Education Scholarship Program

Eligibility Criteria (Applications are reviewed only once per year after the deadline; awards are for the following school year.)

Higher Education Scholarships

Based on academic standing, leadership, financial need, and life experiences. (Awards for 2006-07 ranged from \$750-\$3,000)

Eligibility Requirements:

- *BBNC shareholder
- *high school diploma or equivalent (GED)
- *enrolled in an accredited college or university as a full time student
- *cumulative 2.0 grade point average or better
- *able to show financial need

Vocational or Part-Time Higher Education Scholarships

Established to encourage further educational or career advancement. Vocational or higher education scholarships for \$500 are awarded for the academic year.

Eligibility Requirements:

- *BBNC shareholder
- *high school diploma or equivalent (GED)
- *enrolled in an accredited vocational institution, college or university as a full or part time student carrying at least six credits
- *cumulative 2.0 grade point average or better
- *able to show financial need

H. Noble Dick Scholarship Up to \$1,000

Established in memory of the late H. Noble Dick/BBNC President from 1980-1987.

Eligibility Requirements:

- *BBNC shareholder
- *junior or senior enrolled as a full time student with an accounting or business management major in an accredited college or university
- *cumulative 2.5 grade point average or better
- *able to show financial need

NEW for 2007-08 SpecPro Scholarship at \$10,000 per year & potentially renewable for up to 4 ½ years!

Established to provide an opportunity for higher education and career development and to encourage interest in careers relevant to SpecPro company technical and management fields.

Eligibility Requirements:

- *BBNC shareholder
- *entering 2007-08 freshman enrolled at an accredited college or university
- *full time/degree seeking student with an engineering, environmental, marketing, management, information technology, life science or other appropriate field of study
- *cumulative 3.0 grade point average or better

Wells Fargo – BBNC Scholarship Up to \$5,000

Established to further advance the education of Alaska Natives and to encourage interest in the banking profession, Wells Fargo and BBNC entered into a multi-year scholarship commitment, whereby each contributes \$2,500 to the fund.

Eligibility Requirements:

- *BBNC shareholder
- *junior or senior enrolled as a full time student in an accredited college or university
- *cumulative 2.0 grade point average or better
- *able to show financial need

Pebble Project - BBNC EF Scholarships Up to \$5,000

Established through funding received from Northern Dynasty Mines, Inc. to encourage further education or career advancement and interest in the mining industry.

Eligibility Requirements:

- *BBNC shareholder
- *entering freshman enrolled as a full time student in an accredited college, university or vocational institution (preference given to graduates from the four Bristol Bay school districts)
- *cumulative 2.0 grade point average or better
- *able to show financial need

Scholarship Grading Criteria

Cumulative Grade Point Average	40%
Essay & Resume	35%
Financial Need	20%
Letters of Recommendation	<u>5%</u>
Total Score	100%



Short Term Vocational/Technical Education Program Scholarship

(Applications are accepted for this scholarship at any time of year, however, the budget is limited. Applications are reviewed on a first come-first served basis and must be complete before an award will be considered.)

Established to provide limited financial assistance for BBNC shareholders who attend short term training to enhance their work or career opportunities. Recipients may receive between \$250 - \$500 per scholarship, depending on the cost/length of the training. Limit is one scholarship per program and one per person per year.
