Bristol Bay Native Corporation (BBNC) provides small donations to a number of organizations throughout the year. We focus our attention to those entities that provide benefit to the greatest number of BBNC shareholders as possible and to those efforts that enhance our Native way of life.

Donations are generally made to non-profit organizations. We typically do not fund individual people. Although BBNC discourages multiple requests during our fiscal year (April 1 – March 31), if you plan on requesting funds multiple times during the year, please contact us well in advance to discuss your annual funding plan.

BBNC has approximately 7,800 shareholders living in Bristol Bay, other communities within Alaska, and the Lower 48 states. If your organization provides benefits or has impact on shareholders of BBNC, we encourage you to contact us. The Shareholder & Corporate Relations Committee of the BBNC Board of Directors governs these guidelines and reserves the right to make any exceptions.

BBNC does not fund:

- Individual or team sponsorships
- Political parties or candidates
- Organizations that discriminate based on race, creed, color, sex or nationality
- Debt

- Contact person and information
- Brief description of the organization and your need
- Amount of request
- Why the funds are needed?
- How the funds will be used?
- A list of other donors to your cause/event
- How BBNC might be recognized for our contributions?
- How does your request benefit BBNC shareholders?
