Statement of Methodology: On behalf of Bristol Bay Native Corporation (BBNC), Strategies 360 conducted a live telephone survey of 800 registered voters in Alaska. Respondents were randomly sampled from a list of registered voters in the state. Surveys were administered April 1-7, 2019 by trained interviewers. A combination of landline and mobile phones were called to ensure greater coverage of the population sampled. The margin of error for a survey of 800 interviews is ±3.5% at the 95% confidence level.
